## Recycle Bins or Carts?

Lake Park's positive response to reduce, reuse, recycle has grown so that Council is looking into offering a separate rolling cart, exclusive for recyclable items, to single-family home residents who have off-street storage for it. Currently small open tote bins are standard issue. WastePro may offer a sky-blue rolling cart with a green lid for recyclables; but only in the same size as the solid green trash cart.

HOA restrictions require all waste collection containers to be stored out-of-sight; not visible to others passing in front of our homes. The solid green trash carts must comply now, as do all recycling containers. Some residences may not have available space for a second cart.

However, if you have a secluded spot in your garage or rear yard for storage of both the standard green trash cart and a new additional recycling cart, please email your address and request to [sandy.coughlin@lakeparknc.gov](mailto:sandy.coughlin@lakeparknc.gov) before April 9. If Council approves April 14, the program could begin in May. The April *Villager* will update.
