This brochure contains detailed information on specific materials accepted for recycling by Union County Public Works. Most properly prepared items are accepted for FREE!


REASONS TO RECYCLE

The following materials are banned from disposal in NC landfills per North Carolina § 130A-309.10. Please recycle instead.

Whole Scrap Tires
Antifreeze
White Goods
Wooden Pallets
Yard Waste

Flattened Food Boxes, Paper Egg Cartons, & Paper Towel Rolls



Flattened Corrugated Cardboard & Paper Bags



Mixed paper, Junk Mail, Magazines, Newspapers & Phone Books

NOT ACCEPTED



- NO Plastic Grocery Bags
- NO Styrofoam
- NO Household Trash
- NO Window or Mirror Glass
- NO Light Bulbs
- NO Wrapping Paper
- NO Aluminum Foil or Trays
- NO Plastic Flower Pots
- NO Antifreeze or Oil Containers
- NO Yard Waste
- NO Dishes Cookware, or Ceramics



MISCELLANEOUS

In addition the following may also be recycled at the SWMC **S** and indicated drop-off sites.



ELECTRONICS: Televisions, Computers & Hardware, Printers, Scanners, Stereos, VCRs, Radios, Cameras, & Cords, Cell Phones, Telephones, Answering Machines, Rechargeable Batteries Only



WHITE GOODS: Refrigerators, Dishwashers, Microwaves, AC Units, Water Heaters, Scrap Metal, Bikes, Bed Frames
