RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH AN ORDINANCE REVIEW COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, The Village of Lake Park, North Carolina seeks to provide the Village ordinances to its citizens, residents, businesses, schools, churches and others in a format that is accessible and uniform in various aspects; and

WHEREAS, The Village of Lake Park, North Carolina Village Council believes it is reasonable and thoughtful to engage in a review of the Village ordinances in regards to their content, format and individually continued necessity; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council desires to engage in an overview and review of the Village Ordinances to consider potential revisions, additions, deletions, formatting and other possible modifications of the Village Ordinances.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village of Lake Park, pursuant to its municipal authority and other applicable laws, hereby creates and establishes a committee known as the Village of Lake Park Ordinance Review Committee (the "Committee"), and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Committee shall be charged with the review and assessment of all current Village Ordinance for purposes of presenting findings and/or making recommendations to the Village Council for potential revisions, additions, deletions or other modifications to form and format of the Village Ordinances, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration and life of the Committee shall be one (1) meeting after the last recommendation is presented to the Village Council, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Committee shall consist of three to five members with at least one but up to three members coming from the elected Council of the Village of Lake Park. Any non-council member shall serve for a term of two years and any appointed Council Member on the Committee shall serve until their term of Office expires or a new Commission member is appointed in their place. All non-council members shall be appointed by virtue of nomination and majority vote by the Village Council. Each meeting shall be public in nature and shall prepare minutes from said meetings for inclusion in the public record, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Committee may review the Village of Lake Park Unified Development Ordinance ("the UDO") but any recommendations for change to those provisions of Village law shall only be made to the Village Council by and through its duly established Planning Board. The Committee may present recommendations regarding the UDO to the duly established Planning Board for their own independent assessment, consideration and possible recommendation to the Village Council in compliance with North Carolina Law. .

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Committee shall meet on at least a quarterly basis and all meetings shall be open to the public pursuant to state law.
