P&RC: Parks & Recreation

♦ **New Patriotic Banners**, to replace the 70 in use on village street lampposts annually from Memorial Day through Labor Day, have been purchased for 2017 installation. The old banners had become tattered and faded. The \$3300 cost is included in the current Flag Replacement budget.

♦ **8 Purple and White Crepe Myrtles** are being planted on the Conifer Street side of Lake Charles by Lucas Landscaping. The \$1200 cost is covered in the Park Maintenance budget.

♦ **Carolina Pool Management** offered a 2017-2019 contract renewal to P&R. Due to the long-standing quality service of CPM's prior contracts with the village and a minimal 1% price increase, Council approved the P&R recommendation to renew.

♦ **Additional Improvements** include playground mulch to top off Founders Park and Russell Park features, and two new park benches for the recently resurfaced tennis courts.

Only recycle carts and bins with the following recyclables will be collected. **Approved recyclables include: Plastics, Glass, Cardboard, Metal Cans, EMPTY Aerosol Cans, flattened Food Boxes, Paper Towel Tubes, Corrugated Cardboard, Paper Bags, mixed junk Mail and Newspapers.**

Yard Waste Guidelines

Please use clear plastic bags for grass clippings, weeds and leaves for Thursday collection. Brush and limbs must be cut into 4-foot lengths, no more than 3 inches in diameter. Do NOT put yard waste in the carts or recycle bins.

Construction Debris

Building material from remodeling, repair or demolition will NOT be collected. No play sets, siding, windows, cabinets. nor broken concrete. Questions: 704-882-8657
