Your chance to be on Village Council is here: Two 4-year terms, one 2-year unexpired term and the 2-year mayor term expire this year. To run for the office of your choice, bring your NC ID and \$5 fee to the Board of Elections, 316-B East Windsor Street, Monroe NC after noon Fri July 7 and before noon Fri July 21.

Proposed ordinance changes are available for public preview at www.lakeparknc.gov or at the Village Office. Two changes are proposed: 1) To allow the deputies discretion whether to give a verbal warning or to issue a citation when a law is broken and 2) To disallow covering identification (VIN, license tags, model/make) when motorized vehicles are parked covered on a public street.
