Street Light Outage?

To provide the most efficient repair times, Union Power has a dedicated webpage to report these outages. In order to report these lights, you will need the post number of the light that is out. The post number is located at the bottom of each light pole (yellow tag with black numbers.) These numbers uniquely identify each pole. Enter outages at union-power.com/light-repair/.

Over the years council has taken the role of reporting the outages. However, these efforts have been done on a monthly basis and is much less efficient than allowing residents to identify and report them on their own.
