Lake Park Comprehensive Plan Survey

Union County Alerts

Union County has launched a new Mass Notification service that allows them to alert you. This service is taking the place of CODE RED. You opt-in to enter your contact information and subscribe to notifications you care about based on your location in the county. The information that you provide is protected and will not be used for any other purpose. When a notification is issued about a potential safety hazard or concern, you will receive a message on the voice or text communication that you have registered. To sign up for notifications, create an account and add your contact information and location information into the Mass Notification system.
