CALL TO ORDER: Chairman James Record called the September 20, 2021 Ordinance Review Committee meeting to order.

PUBLIC COMMENT: There were no public comments.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Minutes Approved, John Corzine made a motion to approve the Aug 16, 2021 minutes, Joe Scaldara Seconded the motion, all in favor.

CHANGES TO THE AGENDA: No changes to the Agenda. Joe Scaldara made a motion to accept the Agenda as presented, Bruce Barton seconded the motion, all in favor.
