

**MINUTES  
VILLAGE OF LAKE PARK  
PARK AND RECREATION COMMISSION MEETING  
3801 LAKE PARK ROAD, LAKE PARK, NC  
JUNE 22, 2015**

**Commission Members Present:** David Cleveland, Fabian Szarko, Ashley Dance and Wayne Daniels.

**Call to Order:** Mayor David Cleveland called the June 22, 2015 Parks and Recreation meeting to order.

**Public Comments:** There was no public comment.

**Approval of Minutes:** Ashley Dance made the motion to approve the May 26th Regular Session minutes as presented. Fabian Szarko seconded the motion. Vote – Unanimous.

**Changes to the Agenda:** Wayne Daniels made the motion to approve the agenda as presented. Ashley Dance seconded the motion. Vote – Unanimous.

**Council Actions:** Council approved the following P&R expenditure:

1. Up-lighting for Veterans Pond - \$2,500.

**Budget Report:** Mayor David Cleveland shared that the following items and services have been received by the Village and payments are pending: swim tags, mulch and up-lighting for Veterans Pond flags. The Front Entrance renovation is under way and looking nice. Mayor David Cleveland shared that P&R should be about \$30,000 under budget even if we paid all of the front entrance renovation. With the weather so hot and dry, P&R will need to appropriate funds next year for the plants at the front entrance.

**Ponds:** Mayor David Cleveland shared that Foster Lake & Pond was in the Village 10 days ago treating the ponds. Sages Pond still has some issues however overall the ponds are looking good. Fabian Szarko shared that he has removed quite a few beer cans from Alden Pond.

**Community Center:** Mark Phillips shared that Carolina Sound System has provided a quote for a PZM sound system - \$1,800.

**Landscaping:** Lucas Landscaping has the rock in place and has turned on the water feature at the front entrance. The lights should be installed tomorrow. Due to the weather, the plants will be installed in the fall.

Byrum Pressure Washing should finish pressure washing today.

The decorative benches should be installed this week and the composite benches are expected anytime. Lucas Landscaping is going to clean up the location for the Logan Circle bench. The bench will be placed on the pad facing the pond.

The Veterans Pond Flag up-lighting was approved by Council however Jonathan Baucom's Electric does not think they can get to the project before the end of the fiscal year.

Kiker Tree Service has quoted \$973 to remove the three dead trees on common property in the Village this week. Ashley Dance made a motion to approve the tree removals. Fabian Szarko seconded the motion. Vote – Unanimous.

**Pool:** There are 220 pool season memberships to date and the revenue for memberships to date is \$47,585.


**Events:** Ashley Dance shared that due to donations the Memorial Day Event was under budget \$67.29. The total expense for the event \$832.71.

Fourth of July plans are underway. Fabian Szarko suggested that the prizes for the Patriotic Hat Contest be a one day pass to the pool for the winners. Everyone agreed to the prizes. In discussing supplies, Ashley Dance suggested that P&R purchase two coolers. Ashley Dance made the motion to purchase two coolers for \$250. Fabian Szarko seconded the motion. Vote – Unanimous. P&R also decided the Hometown Heroes for 2015.

National Night Out planning is also underway. Ashley Dance is working with the Highway Patrol and Sheriff's Department on exhibits.

**Adjourn:** Ashley Dance made the motion to adjourn. Wayne Daniels seconded the motion. Vote – Unanimous.
